This money was spent on...

Toilets: Toilet seats, toilet brushes, towel holder, towels, scrubbing brushes, mops and

buckets, cleaning materials and toilet paper,

Office: Energy efficient light bulbs and shades, net curtains, electric heater and timer, electric kettle, stationary supplies, key safe, duplicate keys, display cabinet

Bandroom: Electric heater and timer and super-ser gas heater, new presses for bagpipes, varnish and brushes, drum practice pads, drywipe board and marker-pens.

Recognition should also be given to the Band Management Team and other adult members of the band who helped on this project during the summer holidays.

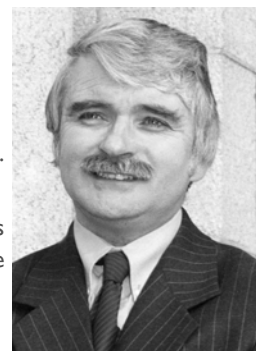
We would request that all members make every effort to maintain these facilities in a clean and tidy condition.

Niedersachsen 2009

Good news! Our tour company have advised that they have now managed to reduce the cost of our proposed tour from €614.00 to €554.00 per person based on 36 people travelling to Niedersachsen from Fri 2nd to Tue 6th October 2009.

Tour Price Includes:

- Shannon/Berlin return flights.
- All landing and departure taxes.
- Baggage allowance.
- 3 nights bed, breakfast and evening meal accommodation in the town of Celle.
- 1 night bed, breakfast and evening meal accommodation in Berlin.
- Coach transfer from airport to hotel on arrival and departure.
- Exclusive use of luxury coach for duration of tour.
- Fully comprehensive insurance cover.
- Emergency service while abroad.

In order to confirm the above tour a 1st deposit of €150 per person is required by Mon 1st Dec. along with a typed passenger list for all persons travelling. A 2nd deposit of €100 is required on Mon 2nd Feb. 2009.



Attractions:

- The **“Volkswagen Autostadt”** car city in Wolfsburg, which is an exhibition area of the Volkswagen group
- The science museum **Phaeno** - With more than 250 experimental stations, a show crater, a science theatre and the forum of ideas, Phaeno allows you to experience the fascination of technology and science.
- **Marienburg Castle** is one of the most important Gothic revival buildings in Germany.

This has resulted in a significant saving to the band as we would otherwise have been compelled to purchase suit bags in order to contain and protect our band uniforms.

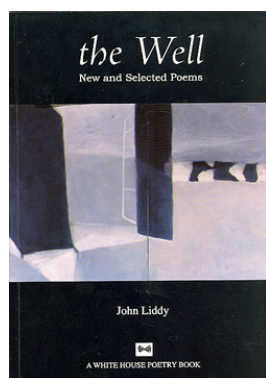
